

“Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.”

These words from today’s Gospel are ones that we often take for granted, without realizing just how challenging they can be. The Risen Savior indeed offers us his peace. His peace goes far beyond any earthly peace we may find. His is a divine peace, a peace that unites us to Him and to one another as a single family of faith. The challenging part comes with the second sentence of the phrase. Jesus “sends” his disciples. For the twelve being “sent” meant all sorts of paths. For some great travels, for others staying closer to home. Regardless, the message is the same. Proclaim the Gospel! Tell others who Jesus is! Help them to know divine peace as well! It is with this in mind that I make this announcement, one of the most difficult I’ve had to make here at St. Agnes.

I am being “sent.”

Archbishop Myers has released me from my responsibilities to the Archdiocese so that I may minister on the faculty of the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio. Now I know what you’re thinking... “OHIO?!” It’s the same reaction most have had! The Josephinum is a seminary that prepares men for the priesthood much like the seminary at Seton Hall. The difference is that it is not directly affiliated with any one diocese. Consequently, the staff comes from all over the country, and my academic degree and parish experience will help me in teaching and preparing seminarians for preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

To be honest I never imagined myself working and living in a seminary in Ohio, but after much prayer and discernment I know that this is of God. The thing to remember in all of this is that the “Peace” that Jesus offers us is not based in a particular place or person, but in allowing his will to work in one’s life...in allowing one’s self to be “sent.”

I will be leaving St. Agnes in mid-June with the standard transfer cycle and begin my work at the Josephinum beginning July 1. Don’t worry. We still have some time to share the Eucharist, prayer...and a laugh or two! St. Agnes is a wonderful parish, full of the life and love of Jesus Christ. All you have to do is welcome whomever is “sent” here. I assure you whoever it is will be a blessed priest indeed!

One final note... Many of you might be wondering about the impact upon my family, given my father’s ongoing battle with cancer. The Rector of the Josephinum has been extremely understanding in this regard, creating a schedule whereby I’ll be able to get home regularly and stay with them should his condition take a sudden turn. Right now, Dad is doing pretty well, thank God. Thanks for all your thoughts and prayers. Please continue to remember him to the Lord. May God bless you all that you know is peace, wherever you are sent to live and proclaim that Jesus is risen!

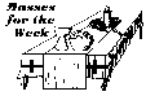

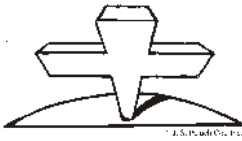
